

Further Recommendations for Rainbow for Girls Web Sites

[These are not required at this time, but are strong recommendation.]

1. Guest Books are not recommended. If a guest book is used it must be closely monitored! E-mail addresses must be removed before the guest book is made available to the public.
2. Advertisements for non-rainbow related items on Rainbow for Girls web pages are not allowed. (Example: Geocities, Yahoo! and such other sites providers who flash the annoying advertisements on your site. Those can and have led to inappropriate sites.)
3. It is preferred that the Supreme Assembly links page (or at least the data on the page) be used. If you have your own links page, it must be closely monitored and not linked to any page not approved by the Supreme Assembly Internet Project.
4. It is preferred that **Grand Assemblies** register a domain and use a domain name, your domain name would be your two letter postal code then IORG.org (example WWW.OKIORG.ORG, WWW.TXIORG.ORG for states in the US, we are working on others)
5. It is recommended that Grand Assemblies work toward enlisting the help of the Masons, Eastern Star, Amaranth, or Majority Members to register a domain and have it connected to the jurisdictional Grand domain. (i.e. www.austin.tx-iorg.org)
6. It is recommended that any possible sensitive information be behind a password protected page, including, but not limited to a list of your state programs, mailing addresses, meeting places and time, etc.
7. The Supreme Assembly Internet Project members use Microsoft FrontPage, they are very knowledgeable with this program, and recommend it as the web page builder of choice.
 - a. The project members can be of assistance if you use this program for your web design. If you have problems, we can help solve them without a costly so-called *professional web service provider*, and we can develop training programs on a state and national level.
 - b. It works well with all standard programs and allows for sub-directory password protection.
 - c. It can be bought under academic pricing and we are looking at nonprofit organization prices.
 - d. There are very reasonably priced web servers available that DO use the FrontPage extensions, allowing a great deal of flexibility in web site development.
8. If you are a professional web designer or have your own favorite program, feel free to use it.

Each local or Grand Assembly is responsible for it's web site contents, cost, development, and maintenance. Supreme Assembly has no liability associated with any site other than the Supreme Assembly web site.

Guidelines and recommendations are subject to change with the approval of the Supreme Assembly Internet Committee and the Supreme Executive Board. Updates will be posted to the Supreme Assembly Web site and e-mailed to Grand Assembly Webmasters. These guidelines go into effect on the anniversary date of the project, November 2, 2000.
