TO RAINBOW GIRLS AND MAJORITY MEMBERS IN GOOD STANDING WHO ARE
INTERESTED IN APPLYING FOR A SCHOLARSHIP

California Rainbow for Girls Foundation, Inc. has a scholarship program designed to provide aid to those girls desiring to enter undergraduate programs (entering freshmen) in college or trade schools. The criteria for scholarships awarded include: Rainbow activity, school and community activity and service, scholarship, and financial need.

The **Rainbow Scholarship** provides aid to those girls desiring to enter under-graduate situations. After the first year, it is felt that other scholarships are available in their chosen fields.

The award is \$500.00, payable in two installments; the first installment will be paid approximately the middle of August and the second **at** the end of the first semester after a transcript of grades and evidence that recipient is continuing in the second semester has been sent to Mrs. Karen Cannon, Chairperson, Scholarship Committee.

Since we are able to function on interest only, limited available funds are available to award. If we deplete the funds, depending on the number of applications received, it will then have to be on a first-come, first served basis. **The California Rainbow for Girls Foundation, Inc. Scholarships** are awarded to entering freshmen first. Any funds not awarded to beginning students are available for continuing student scholarships the next year. **Girls applying for a continuing student scholarship should indicate this when requesting application forms and when submitting their completed scholarship packet.**

The **McDonald Music Scholarship** is available using the same criteria as the Rainbow Scholarship, with one exception; this scholarship goes to a girl who is interested in studying music. The award is \$500.00 payable in two installments, in the same manner as the Rainbow Scholarship.

The **Beverly Sanders Book Scholarship** is available to a Rainbow Girl who is being awarded a regular Rainbow Scholarship who the committee believes needs and deserves the additional funds. This scholarship will be in the amount of \$100.00 to \$250.00 depending on the amount available in the Endowment Fund. Interest only is used for these awards.

The **Jessie D. Nelson Scholarship** is available using the same criteria as the Rainbow Scholarship, with one exception; priority is given to a girl who is interested in the medical field. The award is \$2,500.00 payable in two installments, in the same manner as the Rainbow Scholarship.

The **RAINBOW GIRL HERSELF MUST APPLY FOR THE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION** using one of the following methods:

All forms, in order to be considered, must be filled out COMPLETELY and NEATLY, and sent to the COMMITTEE by the **1st of March** - this means application forms must be postmarked by that date. APPLY NOW FOR FORMS - DO NOT WAIT UNTIL MARCH TO APPLY. The committee will evaluate and select the students to whom the awards shall be given. The names of the girls receiving the scholarship awards will be announced at Grand Assembly. Written verification of the awards will be mailed to the individual girls within two weeks after the close of Grand Assembly.

The Scholarship Committee urges the Mother Advisor, as well as the Chairman of the Advisory Board, to see that this letter is kept on file in the Mother Advisor's binder.

Contributions to the Scholarship Fund may be given as memorials, as well as outright donations or gifts. Checks should be made payable to the **CALIFORNIA RAINBOW FOR GIRLS FOUNDATION, INC.
